

# Summary Of Activities Pertaining To The Ongoing PFAS Investigation In Marinette, Peshtigo And Surrounding Communities

The activities below represent some of the recent activities that have taken place as part of the ongoing investigation into perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) contamination in Marinette, Peshtigo and surrounding communities.

## Recent Activities

- January 2026: The [DNR approves concept](#) JCI/Tyco plans for [monitoring of private wells in the PWSA](#) that have not been replaced by a deep well. JCI/Tyco must notify the affected households for these 24 private wells.
- December 2025: The [DNR reviews](#) JCI/Tyco’s [Documentation of 134 Replacement Deep Private Wells](#) in the PWSA. The report includes initial testing results for 103 properties, which confirm that the treated water from the new deep wells is safe to drink, so long as the treatment systems are maintained. Construction of more deep wells is planned.
- October 2025: The DNR responds to progress reports for the [Ditch A](#) and [Ditch B](#) surface water treatment systems.
